**WHEREAS**, emergencies of all natures occur throughout the day and require the response of police, fire or emergency medical services; and

**WHEREAS**, when an emergency occurs, the prompt response of firefighters, emergency medical services and law enforcement is critical to the protection of life and preservation of property; and

**WHEREAS**, the safety of our first responders is dependent upon the quality and accuracy of information obtained from residents and visitors who telephone the Seminole County 9-1-1 Emergency Communications Center; and

**WHEREAS**, Public Safety Telecommunicators are the first and most critical contact our residents have with emergency services; and

**WHEREAS**, Public Safety Telecommunicators are the single vital link for our firefighters and law enforcement by monitoring their activities by radio, providing them information, and ensuring their safety; and

**WHEREAS**, Public Safety Telecommunicators of Seminole County have contributed substantially to the suppression of fires, treatment of patients, and the apprehension of criminals; and

**WHEREAS**, each telecommunicator has exhibited compassion, understanding and professionalism during the performance of their job in the past year.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED** that the Board of County Commissioners of Seminole County, Florida, proclaim the week of April 9th through 15th, 2023 as:

**“National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week”**

in honor of the men and women whose diligence and professionalism keep our city and residents safe.
