### Background:

The U.S. Department of Justice has announced funding to enhance Adult Treatment Court Services. The award would be for 4 years for up to \$1,000,000.00. If awarded, Seminole County will use the funding to expand the Adult Drug Court's recovery services through access to long-term treatment, housing, vocational and educational services, transportation, and establishing a peer mentor

program.

This solicitation requires a 25 percent cash or in-kind match based on the total project's cost. The match requirement would be provided by personnel support from the 18<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court and Seminole County including the Financial Grant Manager, Problem Solving Courts Manager, State Attorney, and Judge.
