

**JOINT TERMINATION OF TERM CONTRACT FOR
MOSQUITO CONTROL AERIAL ADULTICIDING
AND LARVICIDING SERVICES
(RFP-604988-25/MPG)**

THIS JOINT TERMINATION OF TERM CONTRACT FOR MOSQUITO CONTROL AERIAL ADULTICIDING AND LARVICIDING SERVICES is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 2026, by and between **SEMINOLE COUNTY**, a charter county and political subdivision of the State of Florida, whose address is Seminole County Services Building, 1101 East 1st Street, Sanford, Florida 32771, in this Joint Termination of Term Contract for Mosquito Control Aerial Adulticiding and Larviciding Services (hereinafter “ Joint Termination of Agreement”) referred to as “**COUNTY**”, and **CLARKE ENVIRONMENTAL MOSQUITO MANAGEMENT, INC.**, a Foreign Profit Corporation duly licensed to do business in Florida, whose address is 675 Sidwell Court, Saint Charles, IL 60174, in this Joint Termination of Agreement referred to as “**CONTRACTOR**”.



W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR entered into the subject Agreement on June 17, 2025 for the purpose of CONTRACTOR providing aerial insecticide application support to the Seminole County Mosquito Control Program on an as needed basis; and

WHEREAS, the term for the Agreement commenced on June 17, 2025 and was to continue for a period of three (3) years; and

WHEREAS, Section 9 of the Agreement states that COUNTY may “*terminate this Agreement or any Purchase Order issued under this Agreement, in whole or in part, at any time, either for County’s convenience or because of the failure of CONTRACTOR to fulfill its obligations under this Agreement*”; and

WHEREAS, on the date of July 23, 2026, COUNTY received written email from CONTRACTOR stating that Contractor “*must cease providing fixed wing aerial mosquito control services*”; and

WHEREAS, per the June 23, 2026 email to COUNTY, CONTRACTOR has no ability to provide the required services to the COUNTY; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR have determined that terminating the Agreement through this Joint Termination of Agreement will best serve the needs of all parties,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual understandings and agreements set forth herein, the COUNTY and CONTRACTOR agree as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and form a material part of this Joint Termination of Agreement.

2. COUNTY and CONTRACTOR mutually hereby agree to terminate the Term Contract for Mosquito Control Aerial Adulticiding and Larviciding Services in accordance with Section 9 of the Agreement.

3. CONTRACTOR shall be paid compensation owed by COUNTY, if any, for the services it performed up to the date of termination.

4. As of the date of this Agreement, there are no pending Purchase Orders issued to CONTRACTOR pursuant to this Agreement.

5. The execution date of this Joint Agreement to Terminate shall be the effective date for which the Agreement is terminated.

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IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the COUNTY and CONTRACTOR have executed this Joint Termination of Agreement for the purposes stated above.
