Project History

Midway Drainage Basin – Problem Areas






- Original study conducted in 1997
- Community growth since 1997 has led to strain on the existing system
- Updated Midway Basin study in 2021
- Stormwater model created for entire basin, and recommended five projects, lumped into two Bid Packages
- Federal and state grants to assist with final design and construction of the project received starting of August 2021



Project Timeline






Funding

3 rd Gen Sales Tax + American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) + Grants (EPA, DEP)	\$21.4M
Anticipated 4 th Gen Sales Tax	\$12.1M
Total Est Construction Cost BP1 +BP2	\$33.5M
Spent to Date (ROW + Engineering)	\$10.0M




Midway Drainage Improvement Project












