RECOMMENDATION: Based on the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order, the Code Enforcement Board issue an Order constituting a lien in the amount of \$3,200.00 for 63 days of non-compliance from April 26, 2024, through and including June 27, 2024 at \$50.00 per day, and the fine shall continue to accrue at \$50.00 per day for each day the violation continues or is repeated after June 27, 2024.
