

RESOLUTION

of the

SEMINOLE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE RENAMING OF TIMBERCOVE NORTH TO NORTH TIMBERCOVE AND RENAMING TIMBERCOVE SOUTH TO SOUTH TIMBERCOVE; PROVIDING FOR STREET SIGNAGE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, under the authority contained in Section 336.05, Florida Statutes (2025), and Chapter 90 of the Seminole County Land Development Code, the Seminole County Board of County Commissioners may name and rename streets and roads located within unincorporated Seminole County; and

WHEREAS, the Seminole County Board of County Commissioners has deemed it necessary and in the public’s best interest to rename the street currently referred to as Timbercove North to North Timbercove, and rename the street currently referred to as Timbercove South to South Timbercove, to be consistent with Seminole County’s street naming policies; and

WHEREAS, Timbercove North and Timbercove South are wholly located within unincorporated Seminole County as depicted in the Exhibit Map attached to and incorporated in this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the renaming of the aforementioned streets is consistent with the overall Seminole County plan for street renaming, naming, addressing and the 911 system; and

WHEREAS, adoption of this Resolution will result in the street signs for Timbercove North and Timbercove South being changed to reflect North Timbercove and South Timbercove respectively; and

WHEREAS, all abutting property addresses to Timbercove North and Timbercove South will not be affected by this renaming.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The segment of right of ways, as located within, and depicted on the plat recorded in the Public Records of Seminole County, Florida, are hereby named to **NORTH TIMBERCOVE and SOUTH TIMBERCOVE:**

"Sweetwater Oaks," Plat Book 16, Page 22, depicting Timbercove North abutting Block B lots 13-17 and Timbercove South abutting Block A lots 3-7.

Section 2. This Resolution will become effective upon adoption by the Seminole County Board of County Commissioners.
