Dear County Manager,

On February 12, 2025, the Medical Examiners Advisory Committee for Districts 5 and 24 met and had a very lengthy discussion on how the districts will move forward after the request made on February 4th by Lake and Seminole County to be together in District 24.

Due to the decision of the Medical Examiners Advisory Committee to place the construction of a new Medical Examiner facility on hold, Marion County is requesting to recover \$110,346.53 of incurred costs associated with the planning and design of a new Medical Examiner building. In addition to the \$110,346.53, the current contract with a construction manager allows for up to \$69,010 in fees, if the project were to be cancelled. We have confirmed with the construction manager there will be no fee charged to this project. Therefore, Marion County is requesting to be reimbursed \$29,398.14 from Seminole County for the incurred costs listed above.

The table below explains the allocation for this cost. This table was presented to the Medical Examiners Advisory Committee at the February 12th meeting.
