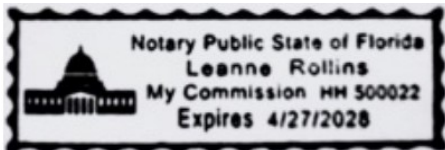

Proposed Substantial
Amendment to the
Seminole County FY2025
One-Year Action Plan
and the FY2025-2029
Consolidated Plan**

On June 23, 2026, the Seminole County Board of County Commissioners (BCC) will be considering the proposed substantial amendment of the FY2025 One-Year Action Plan and FY2025-2029 Consolidated Plan. The One-Year Action Plan and the Five-Year Consolidated Plan governs the allocation and expenditure of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership Program, and the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG).

The proposed Substantial Amendment of the FY2025 One-Year Action Plan and FY2025-2029 Consolidated Plan is to provide an additional allocation of the Rapid Unsheltered Survivor Housing (RUSH) funding under the ESG program where HUD is making available an additional \$113,022 in ESG disaster funding to Seminole County.

- The Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) Program budget will be amended to:
 - Increase the special allocation of ESG funding to address the needs of literal homeless individuals and families, or individuals and families at-risk of homelessness in areas affected by a major disaster.
 - ESG-RUSH funding will be allocated as follows:

This change to the FY2025 One-Year Action Plan allows new funds to be used under the ESG guidelines as it relates to homeless individuals and families, or individuals and families who are at-risk of homelessness that have been residing in an area affected by a major disaster and have needs that will not be served or fully served by the TSA Program and other existing Federal disaster relief programs.

The public comment period will begin on May 24, 2026 and end on June 8, 2026. Comments will be received at the Seminole County Community Services Department through June 8, 2026 at 4:00 p.m. Written comments should be submitted to Carrie Longworth at clongworth@seminolecountyfl.gov.
