

RESOLUTION

of the

SEMINOLE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE DESIGNATION OF THAT PORTION OF S.R. 400 EAST OF THE CENTRAL PARKWAY BRIDGE AND THE E.E. WILLIAMSON ROAD BRIDGE IN THE CITY OF LONGWOOD IN SEMINOLE COUNTY AS “SERGEANT KARL STROHSAL MEMORIAL HIGHWAY”; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Sergeant Karl Strohsal, a dedicated 18-year veteran of the Longwood Police Department and former 14-year officer of the NYPD, was tragically killed in the line of duty on I-4 in Volusia County. While returning from a plainclothes operation, Sergeant Strohsal’s vehicle became disabled after avoiding debris in the roadway. As he exited his vehicle to locate and remove the hazardous obstruction, Sergeant Strohsal was fatally struck by a motorist; and

WHEREAS, Section 334.071(3), Florida Statutes, makes the installation of markers denoting honorary designations of transportation facilities by the Florida Legislature contingent on the formal passage of a resolution of support by each affected local government prior to installation of the markers; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 2025-214, Laws of Florida, designated that portion of S.R. 400 east of the Central Parkway Bridge and the E.E. Williamson Road Bridge in the City of Longwood in Seminole County as “Sergeant Karl Strohsal Memorial Highway” (hereinafter, “Designation”); and

WHEREAS, the roadway that is encompassed by the Designation is maintained by the Florida Department of Transportation (“FDOT”) and is located within Seminole County’s

jurisdiction with abutting properties in the City of Longwood and the City of Altamonte Springs;
and

WHEREAS, the effect of the Designation shall only require the placement of markers by FDOT at the termini or intersections specified above, and to provide authority for FDOT to place other markers as appropriate for the Designation; and

WHEREAS, the Seminole County Board of County Commissioners has reviewed the Designation and hereby supports its adoption; and

WHEREAS, adoption of this Resolution will not result in any address changes, street name changes, or street sign changes for the roadway encompassed by the Designation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The honorary designation of that portion of S.R. 400, located east of the Central Parkway Bridge and the E.E. Williamson Road Bridge in the City of Longwood in Seminole County, is hereby supported by the Seminole County Board of County Commissioners to be designated as “**SERGEANT KARL STROHSAL MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.**”

Section 2. This Resolution will become effective upon adoption by the Seminole County Board of County Commissioners.
