Funding in the amount of \$63,000 is available under this NOFA. Up to 10% (\$6,300) of the award can be utilized for administrative services. The balance must be used for direct service costs of the outreach worker benefits and salary. The non-profit must have at least three years' experience providing street outreach services or can otherwise demonstrate to the satisfaction of the County sufficient expertise to successfully carry out these services. This award shall be available from October 1, 2025, through September 30, 2026. Funding is renewable on an annual basis if performance measures are met.

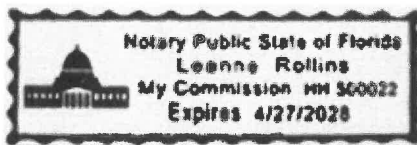

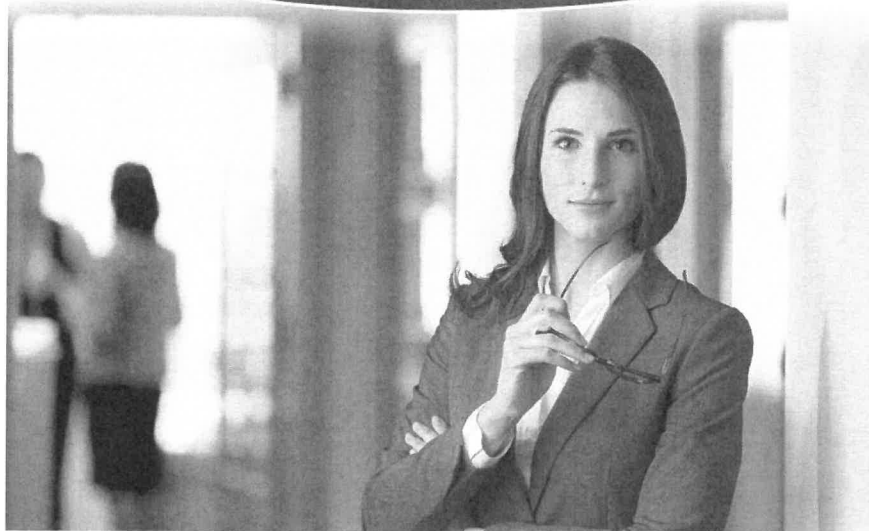
