RECOGNIZING LOCAL FLORIDA HIGH SCHOOL STATE ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION  
SOFTBALL TEAMS**

**WHEREAS**, Seminole County in partnership with the Greater Orlando Sports Commission proudly hosted the Florida High School Athletic Association (FHSAA) State Softball Championships for the first time on May 20–24, 2025, at Boombah Soldiers Creek Park in Longwood, Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, the FHSAA State Softball Championship brought together 32 of the top girls' fast-pitch softball teams from across Florida, each competing in their respective classifications for the prestigious state title; and

**WHEREAS**, Seminole County was represented by three outstanding local teams in the 2025 FHSAA State Softball Championships: The Geneva School, Winter Springs High School, and Hagerty High School; and

**WHEREAS**, The Geneva School softball team finished the season with an impressive 22-4 overall record, District Champions, Regional Champions, and finished as the state runner up in the class 1A State Championship; and

**WHEREAS**, The Hagerty High School softball team finished the season with an impressive 24-7 overall record, District Champions, Regional Champions, and finished as the state runner up in the class 7A State Championship; and

**WHEREAS**, The Winter Springs High School softball team finished the season with an impressive 24-8 overall record, District Champions, Regional Champions, and finished as the State Champions in the class 5A State Championship; and

**WHEREAS**, the student-athletes and coaches of The Geneva School, Hagerty High School, and Winter Springs High School, demonstrated exceptional skill, unwavering dedication, and teamwork throughout their season, earning the admiration of their peers and the entire Seminole County community; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Seminole County Board of County Commissioners does hereby recognize and congratulate the athletes and coaches of The Geneva School, Hagerty High School, and Winter Springs High School for their outstanding performance in the 2025 Florida High School Athletic Association State Softball Championships and commends them for bringing pride and honor to Seminole County.
