

**UNILATERAL TERMINATION FOR CONVENIENCE OF AGREEMENT
(PS-4310-22/GSM)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN this _____ day of _____, 2025, that **SEMINOLE COUNTY**, a charter county and political subdivision of the State of Florida, whose address is Seminole County Services Building, 1101 East 1st Street, Sanford, Florida 32771 (“COUNTY”) hereby unilaterally terminates for convenience the Agreement described below with **GREENMAN-PEDERSEN, INC.**, a foreign profit corporation, whose address is 325 W. Main Street, Babylon, New York 11702, (“CONSULTANT”), and COUNTY states,

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, on October 21, 2022, the parties entered into an Agreement for Engineering Services for Seminole Wekiva Trail Tunnels, Contract No. PS-4310-22/GCM (in this Termination of Agreement referred to as the “Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, COUNTY has determined it is in its best interest to terminate the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the CONSULTANT has been compensated for all services performed through the date of termination and the COUNTY does not owe CONSULTANT any further compensation under the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE,

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and constitute COUNTY’s support for this Unilateral Termination for Convenience.
2. COUNTY hereby unilaterally terminates the Contract for convenience effective July 29, 2025.
3. CONSULTANT is directed to close all of CONSULTANT’s files for COUNTY and return all records of CONSULTANT’s activity to COUNTY, including all data, drawings,

specifications, reports, estimates, summaries, and any and all such other information and materials of whatever type or nature as may have been accumulated by CONSULTANT in performing this Agreement, whether completed or in process, within thirty (30) days of the date of this Unilateral Termination.
