## OF THE SEMINOLE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS RECOGNIZING UNITED STATES NAVY PETTY OFFICER 2<sup>ND</sup> CLASS ADAM ZAVARDINO FOR HIS OUTSTANDING SERVICE TO THE UNITED STATES AND SEMINOLE COUNTY

**WHEREAS,** the brave men and women of our Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force, Coast Guard, and Space Force demonstrate a resolute spirit and unmatched selflessness, reminding us there are few things more American than giving of ourselves to make a difference in the lives of others; and

Eisenhower, completing multiple deployments and earned an additional rating as a Construction Electrician Second Class for the latter half of his enlistment, with one deployment to the Middle East.

WHEREAS, Petty Officer Adam Zavardino has been a resident of Seminole County since 2004. He serves as the prior VFW Commander in Chuluota, and is currently the Post Quartermaster and adjutant for the Winter Springs VFW Post 5405. His efforts have been recognized for the organization of community outreach events, including fundraisers and events honoring first responders in Seminole County. He is a proactive advocate for Veteran's Benefits, working closely with the Seminole County Veteran Services Office to better the lives of local Veterans of all ages; and

**WHEREAS,** Petty Officer Adam Zavardino, has brought great credit and distinction upon himself, the United States of America, the United States Navy, and Seminole County.
