### Dear Supervisor Anderson:

I appreciate your submission of a budget request for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2024-2025. It is my pleasure to inform you that the Board of County Commissioners approved the final budget for the Supervisor of Elections in the amount of \$4,628,683.

As you may recall, your office submitted a proposed budget request of \$4,729,911 in May 2024. Your staff worked with the County Manager and related staff to find additional savings in the budget request of approximately 2.1%.

Upon further review, a final budget was approved by the Board of County Commissioners with an additional \$369,000 in reductions to specific itemized appropriations. These reductions are being moved to a contingency line within the Supervisor of Elections Office's FY 24-25 final approved budget. Of note, the final budget approved by the Board of County Commissioners, in accordance with Florida Statutes 129.201, 129.202, and 129.06(5), does not include itemized appropriations for legal services, building improvements, one-time payments to staff, or out of cycle pay adjustments to staff. (Please see the pertaining Florida Statutes below.)

In summary, the proposed budget your Office submitted has been reduced by 10%. The reductions include the 2% savings we jointly identified in May and an additional 8% that will be placed in the aforementioned contingency line for the next officeholder.

While I appreciate your Office's work during this tight budget year, I continue to be confused by your lack of respect for the public budget process. Please remember, the budget process laid out before us is not mine or yours, it's the peoples. Because Seminole County budgets touch so many services and many aspects of our everyday lives, it is critical for residents and business owners to understand and have the opportunity to participate in the process.

Thank you for your continued leadership in ensuring fair and transparent elections for the citizens of Seminole County.

#### **FLORIDA STATUTES**

F.S. 129.201(4) The board or commission, as appropriate, may require the supervisor of elections to correct mathematical, mechanical, factual, and clerical errors and errors of form in the proposed budget. At the hearings held pursuant to s. 200.065, the board or commission may amend, modify, increase, or reduce any or all items of expenditure in the proposed budget as submitted under subsections (1) and (2); and, as amended, modified, increased, or reduced, such budget shall be approved by the board or commission, which must provide written notice of its action to specific items amended, modified, increased, or reduced.

F.S. 129.202(1a) represents the budget of the Supervisor of Elections, matters related to allocation, expenditure, etc., of the amounts in budget.

It states that the Board of County Commissioners shall pay 25% of the total amount of the budget for the office in October of each year and 6.82% of the total amount budgeted for the office on the first of each month thereafter.

F.S. 129.06(5) represents the execution and amendment of budget. It states that any county constitutional officer who has not been reelected to office or is not seeking reelection, is prohibited from transferring funds between itemized appropriations, or expending more than one-twelfth of any itemized approved appropriation in a single month following the date he or she is eliminated as a candidate or October 1<sup>st</sup>, whichever comes later without Board approval.
