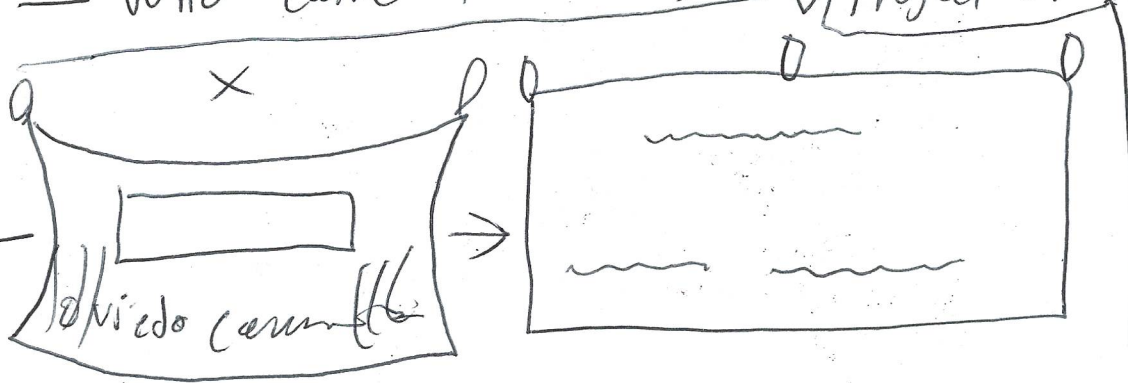

OR

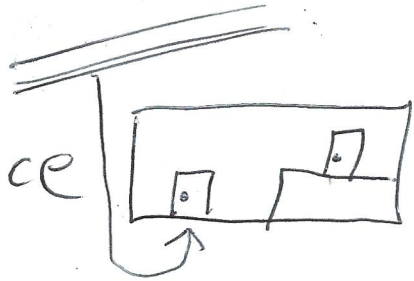
- Meeting with food + drinks + Kona ice + advertise at schools ~~for~~ churches.
