Adoption of the proposed ordinance includes identification of the assessment boundary, establishing the assessment boundary, establishing one benefit unit per assessable waterfront property, and establishing an annual variable rate assessment. an annual variable rate assessment. The total assessment per benefit unit over the next five years is estimated at \$1,303.80 per benefit for ongoing services. The annual assessment amount is estimated at \$260.76.
