

areas affected by a major disaster declared pursuant to the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5121 et seq.) on or after December 20, 2019, whose needs are not otherwise served or fully met by existing Federal disaster relief programs, including the Transitional Sheltering Assistance (TSA) program under such Act (42 U.S.C. 5170b). Seminole County received \$386,784 in special ESG Rapid Unsheltered Survivor Housing (RUSH) funds in December 2022. HUD has recently notified Seminole County of a second RUSH award in the amount of \$125,578.

BAR #24-064 in the amount of \$125,578 appropriates budget for the grant. There is no match requirement for this grant.

Requested Action:

Staff requests the Board approve and authorize the Chairman to execute a Resolution implementing Budget Amendment Request (BAR) #24-064 in the amount of \$125,578 through the Emergency Shelter Grant Fund to appropriate the grant funding from HUD for the ESG Rush second award amount for rapid unsheltered survivor housing.
